

Academic classes "Learning Habits" Rubric

Learning habits include skills that a student exhibits which affect their learning, but do not have a great mathematical impact on the academic grade. (Although there may be a correlation between a child who does not complete his/her work, is not regularly prepared, etc., and a poor academic grade.)
