

Course registration notes for the 2010-2011 School Year

On-line Registration:

Access will be open beginning April 5, 2010 and be closed on April 12, 2010. *You must make your course selections during this time period.* Log onto your Powerschool account (Parent Access) using the regular username and password used to view grades. To activate an account for the first time, see instructions at www.nrsd.net labeled "Powerschool/Powerlunch Parent Access" on the left hand side of the screen.

Once logged in, there will be a new screen available that is accessed by clicking on the "Class Registration" icon.

To assist any family that does not have computer access in the home, there are computers in the school that will be made available for students to complete their course requests. Please notify your guidance counselor if you need computer assistance to complete the registration.

Program of Studies: Read through CAREFULLY and COMPLETELY – this is your best guide to what is offered, what prerequisites are required, etc. Review the Graduation Requirements listed on page six.

On-Line Registration Highlights: Fully detailed instructions are attached, but many will find the screens self-explanatory and easy to navigate. A few points to note:

- In accordance with school policy, each student must request, and enroll in, a minimum of 24 credits a year. The system will not save a student's requests that do not meet this total.
- English and Wellness are mandatory for every student – you will not be able to exit the screen without making selections in these departments.
- The course your teacher recommended for you will be bold and at the top of the list – a leveled course for which you were not recommended will not be available for selection. Speak to your teacher if you wish to take additional courses in this subject area. Should you choose to initiate an override request, forms are available in the main office and Guidance: *deadlines will be strictly enforced.*
- Although teacher recommendations are not required for Wellness, all Freshmen must enroll in Wellness 9 and all Sophomores must enroll in Wellness 10.
- You may choose up to five electives: Note – electives are listed alphabetically and we recommend that you have the Program of Studies handy to help navigate this lengthy list.



1. Log in using your normal PowerSchool Username and Password.

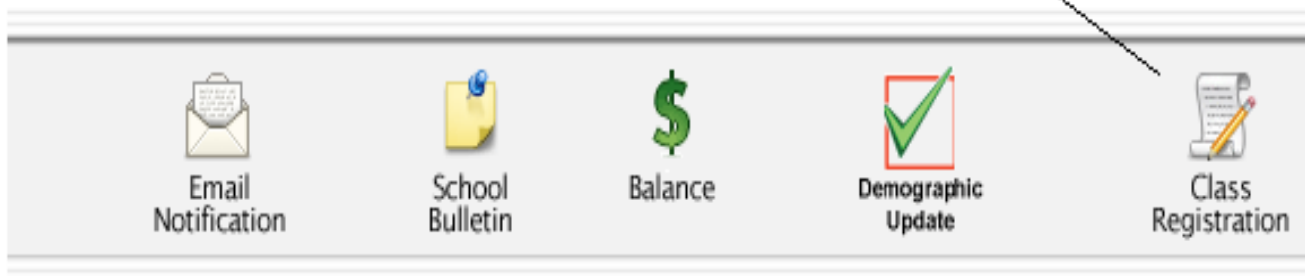
