

Power Lunch *Announcement from George P. King, Jr, Assistant Superintendent of Schools.*

PowerLunch: The Nashoba Regional School District will be transitioning to an electronic lunch payment system called PowerLunch starting with the first day of school, September 2, 2009. Beginning on that day, students will no longer have the option of using cash to pay for lunches; rather, they will use a pre-established five digit numerical code which will be assigned to each student.

There are two ways to use the new identification process. Each student will have the option of typing in their own five digit lunch number or reciting it to the cafeteria employee.

To add money to individual accounts, prepayments are made by using Mastercard, Discover, or a check routing number by accessing the link on the main page of the district website (<http://www.nrsd.net/>); or, by obtaining a cash/check envelope and returning it to our secure lockbox. Both the cash/check envelopes and lockbox will be located in the school main offices. The prepayment amount will be submitted into each student's account in either instance; however, please allow 24/48 hours for that to be recorded.
