Jobs were hard to find and slaves prices were high. Women were hard workers and had many jobs to complete during the course of the day. Some of the jobs the women did were...cleaning out side and around the house, taking care of the children, cooking, and making candles. These jobs were both very physically and mentally tiring. The women woke up early in the morning and went to sleep late at night. These few examples are only some of the tasks preformed back in colonial times.

Men also had jobs in the colonies. The men in Georgia were involuntary soldiers. An involuntary soldier is a man of basically any age who is the chosen for a family to go to war for there country. They planted the crops and took care of all the farm animals.

There were many jobs to be done around the home back in the colonies and all of the family members had a fairly packed day of cleaning cooking plant and weaving. All these tasks needed to be completed and all of the family members... even the children had important tasks to complete.

Home life

Georgia home life

In the homes of Georgia manners and etiquette were highly thought of. Children were always busy and tools and crops always needed to be tended to. Some of the following tools were used in the colonists every day life's. Hand axes were one of the commonly used tools. This tool was to hollow out bowls and other materials. Another tool that was used commonly was the draw knife which was used to trim boards and taper shingles. Last but not least there was a tool called the dog which got round logs to stand still while cutting them down to size. These were only some of the tools used in the colonists long days.

Education to Georgia was very important and common. Most children who were educated were boys. The boys were taught to read and write while the girls did all the cleaning and cooking. Most boys were taught at home by a paid teacher. After school the boys would work in the fields with their fathers and plant crops. Most of the time the men hired slaves to help them work in the cotton fields.



The cotton fields were worked in daily by the men and slaves.

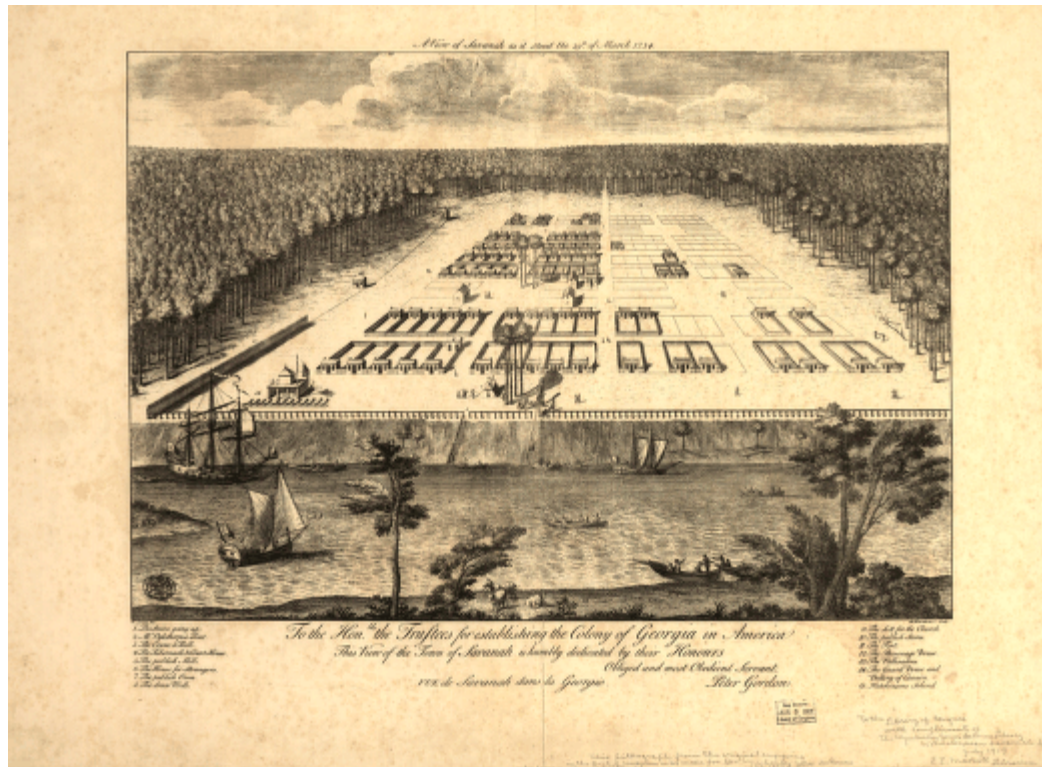
Founding of the Colony!!!!

Georgia one of the southern colonies was founded in January 13th of 1733 by James Oglethorpe. after James Oglethorpe and some of his men were settled other colonists started settling in Savanna Georgia. Savanna is the capital of the modern day state but back then it was the first town to be settled on. The land there had rich soil which made it so prosperous for farming. the later colonist were from Spain they came down the coast with Ponce De Leon who was in search of the fountain of youth. him and his men then started to settle and spread out through out the colony.

When the settlers came to the colony they found flat dry land which as I have mentioned before it was extraordinary good for farming
