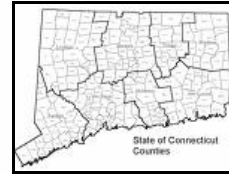


Connecticut

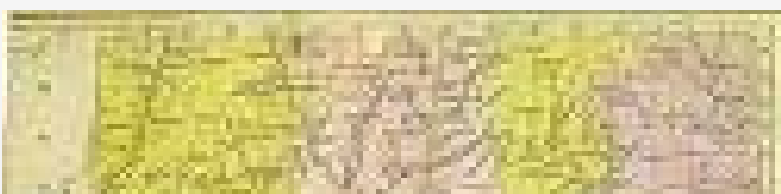
The economy

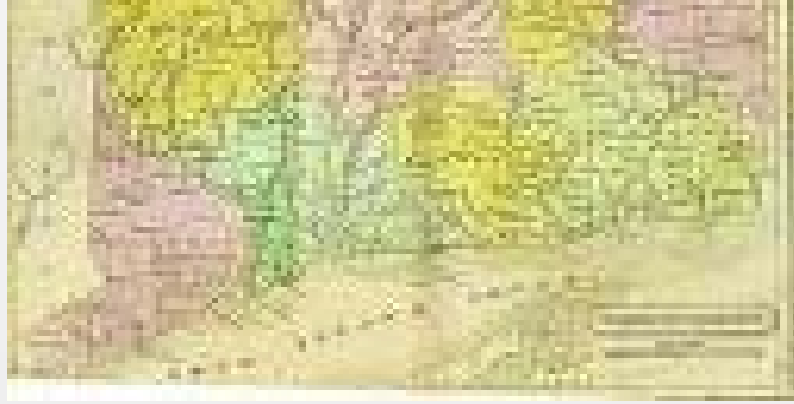

The Geography Of Connecticut

The Connecticut colony covers

5,544 miles of land. There is 698 miles of land in the state of Connecticut and the rest it is water. The highest point in Connecticut is 2,380 feet above sea level and the lowest point is directly as sea level. The main elevation of the state Connecticut is about 500 feet above sea level. One of the main rivers in Connecticut is the Connecticut river.
